

Meeting of Thursday July 17th 1913

Resolved that under

Item 1.

If a student of the Hygiene Course has already passed one or more of the primary subjects in the diploma or the B.Sc. examination, or its equivalent, she may, subject to the approval of the teacher and the external examiner, be excused from sitting for the examinations in the diploma in that subject.

But the student will not be excused from ^{attending} the course of lectures and practical work of the subject.

It was resolved in ^{the} 1913 course

to excuse

Miss Treedy from the examination in Typing for the diploma

and Miss Bradley from the examination in Typing and Chemistry subject to her passing the B.Sc. exam in those subjects.

Item 2.

It was decided that the teacher and external examiner for the Hygiene diploma should meet regularly after each examination and that for the purpose they be formed into a Board with

Mr. F. Womack as Chairman and

Mr. J. A. H. Brincker as Convenor.

It will be the duty of the Chairman and convenor to arrange as

(1) ^{follows} dates of examination

(2) for the examination questions papers to be sent for the approval of the external examiner

(3) for the meeting of the examiners as soon after the examination as possible.

(4) to report the decisions of the Board to the Principal
