Resolved That under

Item 1.

If a student of the Hygiene Course has already passed over more of the preliminary subjects for the diploma in the B.Sc examination, or its equivalent, she may, subject to the approval of the teacher and the external examiner, be excused from sitting for the examination in the diploma in that subject. ^{attending} But the student will not be excused from ~~the~~ the course of lectures and practical work of the subject.

It was resolved in ^{the} 1913 course

to excuse
Miss Treaty from the examination in Physics for the diploma
and
Miss Bradley from the examination in Physics and Chemistry subject to
her passing the B.Sc exam in those subjects.

Item 2.

It was decided that the teacher and external examiner for the Hygiene diploma should meet regularly after each examination and that for the purpose they be formed into a Board will
