Further to my letter of 1st November, I have now had a meeting with Mr. Ron Hoy and Mr. Everest, Education Officer of the ENB, Psychiatric Division.

Mr. Hoy said that he would get in touch with you about the detailed arrangements and I shall be seeing him again in this connection on December 2nd.

I am writing to you now in relation to preliminary arrangements for the students and I would have thought that the theoretical experience of last year could be repeated. As I need to give my students some guidance as to what to expect, where to go on their first day and anything else of importance, I should be glad if you could let me know these details.
