Dear Sir,

With further reference to my letter to you of the 31st
December, I now enclose * pamphlets to show the ground covered
by the State Examination for Health Visitors and the courses
in Psychology and Psychiatry added by this College for their
foreign students. Under present conditions the State does
not require a knowledge of Psychology and Psychiatry from
qualified Health Visitors but as I pointed out in my letter
referred to above, this College regards a knowledge of such
subjects as essential.

We further hope that if a course for English Health Visitors
including Psychology and Psychiatry could be inaugurated it
might be a means of spreading knowledge on these important
subjects to workers among young children.
