Dear Miss Monkhouse,

I am authorized by the Secretary General to inform you that Recommendations 2 and 3 contained in your letter of February 8th were laid before the Executive Committee at its meeting held on April 5th and were approved.

The Executive Committee will meet again in October, and expressed a wish that the result of your study of the question of the continuation of the Courses be brought before the Committee at its next meeting.

Am I right in thinking that it is a matter for the finance committee of Bedford College to discuss first, and that the question will then come up for discussion at the meeting of the Committee for the Organization of the Courses which has been arranged for the end of May? I am planning to be in London at the end of May for this meeting before leaving for Canada in June. If you think, however, there is anything to be gained by my coming over at the end of April to talk over the question with you and the Principal, I will arrange to do so.
