BSc IN NURSING STUDIES

I am writing to ask whether you will be able to let me have very shortly either a course outline or a formal course proposal form (the latter would have to go through the College Registrar, Mr Turnbull) for the first-year course in Physiology and Anatomy. We shall need these details in time for the next meeting of the Special Advisory Committee on 15 May, if the course is to be approved before its introduction next October.

As I think you will have been aware from previous discussions, and also from discussions which Professor Green and I had with Dr Burton, the Special Advisory Committee in Nursing hopes that it will be named as the Board of first instance in all courses specially designed for the BSc degree programme in Nursing Studies, even when the title of the course might seem to indicate reference to another Board of Studies, eg, Psychology, Physiology, Sociology. All the relevant Boards of Studies have representatives on the Special Advisory Committee, which has agreed that this is the most satisfactory way of retaining an overall idea of the content of the courses. We shall be sending out the agenda immediately after the Bank Holiday on 4 May, so that I hope you can let me have details by not later than 29 April.

I would add that the first-year courses in Nursing and Sociology have both received final approval from Professor Green on behalf of the Committee.
