Sir,

The Council of Bedford College has, at the request of the Joint Consultative Committee of Institutions Recognised by the Minister of Health for the Training of Health Visitors and of Organisations of Health Visitors, given consideration to the question of the minimum period which should be required for the training of Health Visitors, for which career students are trained at Bedford College. I am directed to send you the following resolution which was passed by the Council of Bedford College after receiving a report from its Academic Board:

"That in the opinion of the Council of Bedford College it is desirable that the minimum duration of Training Courses for Health Visitors should be increased from six to nine months."
