TELEPHONE MESSAGE from Miss McEwan. College of Nursing.

November 25th, 1931.

Re. Fees for Special Course in Social Administration given by Mrs. Reid.

The College of Nursing would be glad if Bedford College would arrange for the course to be given at a fee of £50 payable by the College of Nursing, irrespective of the number of students attending the course, provided such an arrangement may be made for two years only in the first instance and the matter be reconsidered at the end of two years. The reason for this condition is that it has already been suggested that the College of Nursing is over-training for Health Visitors and the numbers have actually been dropping and may drop still further next year.
