Miss Rundle has passed your letter of May 14th on to me. The explanation is that lecture fees for non-College Members are one-third more than the fees charged for members; thus, for the course in Tropical Diseases, the fee charged for Miss Hamblin and Miss Hills Young, who are both College Members, was £1:1:0. and the fee for the other students was £1:8:0. Similarly, for the course in Principles of Education, £1:5:0. was charged for Miss Hamblin and £1:13:4. for the other students.

On the statement sent down from this Department, "College Member(s)" was placed beside the appropriate items, but I find on enquiry that the clerk in the Accountants' Department omitted this in the bill sent to you, and I must apologise for the oversight.
