**Fees.**—Single lectures may be attended for a fee of 2s. 6d. for College members and 3s. for non-members, except where otherwise stated. For non-members all fees are increased by one-third.

**Diploma in Nursing, University of London.**—Special courses of study are arranged to meet the needs of students preparing for this examination.

**Health Visitors.**—The College of Nursing is a centre approved by the Ministry of Health for the training of Health Visitors. The courses, of six months' duration begin in September and January.

**Hospital Administration.**—A year's course for Nurse Administrators and Teachers in Schools of Nursing is arranged at Bedford College in conjunction with the College of Nursing.

**Sister-Tutors.**—A course of three academic terms is established at King's College of Household and Social Science. Scholarships are offered by the College of Nursing to enable members to enter for this special course of study.

**Central Midwives Board Examination for Midwifery Teachers, 1932.**—A special course of study is arranged in co-operation with the Midwives Institute to meet the needs of students preparing for this examination.

**Coaching for State Examinations.**—Under certain conditions special coaching for the State Examination is offered, either in classes or by correspondence.
