Dear Mrs. Carter,

I send you for your information minutes of our sub Committee meeting held on Tuesday, December 13th, about the Summer School. Will you be good enough to let me have answers to the following questions:-

- a. What is the position as regards Lecturers such as Miss Johns, Miss Bridge, Miss Hodgman etc? Is there any likelihood of their being allowed by their particular organisation to consider an invitation from the Council of Bedford College? If so, will the League of Red Cross Societies be prepared to defray their travelling expenses and give them hospitality?
- b. Can you give me any idea of the fees which would have to be offered to such lecturers?
- c. I presume the leader of the discussion would not expect payment. Would travelling expenses be met?
- d. Will you let me have proper titles and addresses of persons mentioned in (a) so that they may be approached officially?

Please forgive me for troubling you about this matter, but without this information it will be impossible for me to report satisfactorily to the Committee on January 13th as to whether your request for the salaries of the Lecturers

to be paid out of the grant ^{can be met} ~~given by~~ you. Also if you know of any suitable Lecturers who will be in Europe at the time of the Summer School, will you mention them to me ^{when} ~~in~~ writing?
