re: Borrowing rights for Bedford College Nursing Students (10) 1985/86

I am writing to you in relation to 10 students of Bedford College who are undertaking a Degree in Nursing Studies and whose final year will be 1985/86.

As you may be aware, Bedford College is vacating the Regent's Park site in July 1985 to merge with Royal Holloway College at Egham. The only undergraduates not joining the Egham site will be 10 nursing students whose course is being phased out in 1986 and who will be placed for that last year in 11, Bedford Square in Central London. The students are doing their practical placements in the Middlesex Hospital and at UCH.

Borrowing library facilities for that last year is one of our main headaches as Bedford Library will be moving to Egham but the students' time, because of their practical placements, will be so cortailed that using the Egham Library is not a feasible proposition.

I therefore wonder whether you might be able to accommodate for borrowing rights the 10 of my students as an ad hoc arrangement for the Academic Year 1985/1986
