Public Health Students - January - May 1938.

Three of our public health students joined the study week arranged in Birmingham by Dr. Mess for the Social Studies' students. Our two English Health Visitors found it most illuminating, giving them a picture of the social services and the industrial conditions of a typical district. Miss Lagercrantz, the third member was particularly interested as she will be returning to Sweden to take a post as a hospital almoner.
