

Resolution of Bedford College Finance Committee

17th February 1939.

ii. Fees for Psychiatry Courses.- Florence Nightingale International Foundation.

Reported that arrangements for the Psychiatry teaching for the Florence Nightingale International Foundation students had recently not met the needs of the students, with the result that they had often applied to attend courses outside the College. That the matter had been reviewed by the teachers concerned at Bedford College and their recommendations involved a possible increase of £30 in payment of Visiting Lecturers.

The Principal supported the proposal on the grounds that the Florence Nightingale International Foundation students had very special needs and paid on that account a high fee.

RESOLVED that in view of the special needs of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation students and the high fees paid by them on this account the estimate for fees for Visiting Lecturers for these students be increased by £30.
