Madam,

I am directed by the Minister of Health to draw attention to the Memorandum 101/M.C.W. recently issued in regard to the training of Health Visitors, a copy of which has already been forwarded to you, and I am to enquire whether the Bedford College for Women propose to submit to the Minister schemes for courses of training under paragraphs 3 and 4 of Part II of the Memorandum. If so, I am to suggest that the proposed schemes of instruction and training should be submitted as soon as possible, together with a statement of the fees proposed to be charged for each course, and a further statement showing what facilities for obtaining six months' hospital training will be available for the students taking the two years' course.
