"The Board of Governors,

Endorsing the action by which the Executive Committee has pledged the support of the League to the plan of the International Council of Nurses to establish a "Florence Nightingale International Foundation", taking as basis the international nursing courses instituted by the League in London,

Expresses its thanks to the American National Red Cross for enabling the League to continue to finance the present courses up to July 1933,

Urges the national Red Cross Societies to cooperate with the National Nursing Associations in securing funds for the proposed Foundation, and notably in raising the sum of L5,000 in the form of 20 scholarships of L250 each, necessary to allow of the courses being carried on through the academic year 1933/34,

And requests Sir Arthur Stanley, in conjunction with two members of the Secretariat to be designated by the Secretary General, to constitute, with three members of the International Council of Nurses, an interim committee for the purpose of making arrangements for the 1933/34 courses.
