Dear Miss Monkhouse,

May I be allowed to draw your attention to the proposals concerning payment of tuition fees between Bedford College and the College of Nursing which accompanied a letter dated July 18th 1929.

On page 2 and 3 it ^{was} stated that ~~in future~~ members of the College of Nursing attending lectures at Bedford College should be allowed the benefit of intercollegiate rates and for a course of 6 lectures the charge of £1: 1: 0 per student would in future be 17/9d.

I note that this was confirmed in a letter from you dated November 14th 1929, and this being the case, may I venture to return the enclosed account for correction.
