Dear Elizabeth,

I am writing to you to find out whether you might agree to become one of the examiners for the fourth and final year of our Nursing Studies degree at Bedford College. As you know, this degree is in the process of being phased out but there are the two final years to be examined, one in the summer of 1985 and the other in the summer of 1986.

Bedford College operates London University's course unit system. This involves, for the final year, two separate tasks: one the actual marking of scripts in two subject areas, and the other related to the classification of the degree.

The subject areas to be examined in the fourth year is one course in management and one course in the care of the elderly, and I would very much appreciate it if you could do both of them. Students will also be examined on their final dissertations which is the responsibility of Jean McFarlane. The first finalists, graduating in 1985, comprise only five students; the group graduating in 1986 consists of eleven students.
