Instruction in Cookery &c.

Madam,

I beg to inform you that your letter of the 20th instant respecting the certificates awarded to students who have completed their attendance at the Bedford College course of scientific instruction, has been considered by the School Management Committee of the Board together with a report of the Sub-Committee on Instruction in Cookery &c.

I am directed to point-out that there are no Teachers of Hygiene engaged by the Board, but that there are some appointments made such as Instructress-ships in Cookery, Housewifery, and Laundry-work in which the candidates are required to obtain the Science & Art Hygiene certificate or a certificate of equivalent value if they do not possess one at the time of engagement.
