Dear Mrs. Carter,

In reply to your letter of 1st June Miss Baggallay's salary for this year is £25 more than last year because St. Thomas's Hospital is only contributing £75 instead of £100. This is by arrangement with Bedford College, because we found that St. Thomas's Hospital made too large a claim on Miss Baggallay's time, so she has since the end of March become full time at Bedford College and no longer goes part time to St. Thomas's Hospital. I ought perhaps to have explained this to you when I sent in the bill, and I apologise for the omission. If the League are not prepared to meet this extra £25, my Council will of course understand.

The refund of Miss Hole's fees was sent to you last week, so I hope you have received it some little time since.
