Dear Mrs. Carter,

I was just writing to you when I received your letter of the 5th February. You were quite right in thinking that the date of the presentation of the Certificates was fixed for Tuesday July 8th at 3.30 p.m. and at the meeting of the Council yesterday the following recommendations of the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students were approved:-

"That in the first place Miss Margaret Bondfield be invited to present the certificates to the International Students in July 1930.

That failing Miss Bondfield, Lady Astor be invited.

That Mrs. Carter be asked to arrange for the invitation to go from Sir Arthur Stanley, Chairman of the British Red Cross."

I have spoken to the Principal about your suggestion concerning speakers and both she and Mrs. Reid agree that if Miss Bondfield makes a speech it will be well to omit the Nursing Address by Miss Snellman.

I must apologise for not letting you know before that we have received £15 from the Ministry of Health on behalf of Miss Hamblin and I enclose a cheque for this amount.
