1926 Title of Public Health Course changed to "Course in Public Health Nursing."

1926 Advisory Ctte of the League of Red X Societies submitted a scheme for development of Public Health Nursing Course at B.C.

Desire to combine more closely the Practical & Theoretical ^{Work.}
Pointed out that up to the present most of the subjects had been dealt with by sending the students to different centres which entailed considerable loss of time + did not give a satisfactory linking up with course as a whole.

Practical training arranged in co-operation with Battersea Borough Council. B.C. paid salary of a Health Visitor in return for training facilities for International Students.

1927 March. New financial arrangements started.

Before this the league had paid 45 guineas per student.

1927 October. Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students ~~first~~ (a B.C. Committee)

met for the first time. (Replaced the League's Joint
Advisory Committee)
Committee responsible for :-

- (1) Admissions of Students
- (2) Arrangement of Courses
- (3) Expenditure of League Grant.

1928 March. Training for Public Health Students in conjunction with Battersea Borough Council given up. ~~Practical Work~~ New scheme for 2 years ~~run~~ in conjunction with Social Service Department at St. Thomas's Hospital started.

1928 May. Miss Baggalby appointed Tutor to the Public Health Students - to be responsible for the Practical Training of the International Students in Health Visiting work under the auspices of St. Thomas's Hospital.

1928 July. (16th July to 4th August) 3 Weeks Summer School for Old Internationals held at Bedford College. Attended by 79 old students from 27 different countries - (+5 outside members)

1928 July. Office in Kennington Road secured for centre for Training for Public Health Students.

1928 October. Changes in Certificate - in future only to be awarded on rec. of B.C. Org. Committee.
