Dear Mrs. Newton Robinson,

I enclose a copy of the item from the Board's agenda of 17th October, which you asked Mr. Bond to send to you. I do not think it would be of very much service for Bedford College ^{alone} to oppose the registration of the proposed company, but if other institutions engaged in teaching sanitary science, such as King's College and the London Polytechnics thought it desirable to make some representation, they might hold a conference and send some combined memorandum to the Board of Trade which might be effective. I believe that the registration is being delayed through opposition from the sanitary inspectors themselves, and I do not know whether any other body has taken up the cudgels.
