Dear Mrs. Carter,

At the meeting of the Council of Bedford College held yesterday the proposed endorsement of the certificates as recommended by the Organisation Committee was before them. The proposed wording did not quite meet with the approval of the Council and they asked that it should be amended as follows:-

"The student has done satisfactory work throughout the course and has attained in her work during that time the required standard in..... with distinction in the following subjects....."

The Council were anxious that the wording should leave no opening for a false impression that an examination had been held. I send it you now in case it is necessary to have the certificates printed before our May meeting. As a matter of form it should go before the Organisation Committee first but it is not, I think, of sufficient moment to justify a special meeting being called as it is really only making clear what the Organisation Committee intended.
