Thank you very much for the copy of the minutes of the meeting held on January 12th. It was good of you to send them so promptly.

The result of the informal meeting arranged by Sir Arthur Stanley, when the members of the Red Cross met with the delegates of the International Florence Nightingale Memorial Committee to discuss the possibility of the League's Course at Bedford College becoming the basis of the new scheme, was very encouraging and Acting Secretary General cabled to the Chairman for authorization to continue for another year. An answer to this cable has just been received from the Chairman authorizing the League to organize a Course for 1932/33 session.
