Dear Miss Morris,

I rang up your office to-day to know whether you could spare time to come to a meeting at Bedford College on Friday 16th February at 2 p.m. to discuss the proposal for giving International students some training for Almoners' work. Someone who answered the telephone in your absence told me she thought that you were free at that time but she would ask you to let me know if this should not be the case. I hope to send you early next week draft proposals for a course of training in Social work for International Nurses which are intended to form the basis of any specialised social work which the student may wish to take up afterwards. It is the consideration of this course as a basis for training in Almoners work which the committee would be glad to discuss with you at the meeting on the 16th.
