I. COURSE FOR NURSE ADMINISTRATORS AND TEACHERS IN SCHOOLS OF NURSING.

a) Applications for admission have been received from the following candidates who fulfil the requirements and are therefore recommended for admission by the League of Red Cross Societies:

b) An application was received from the German Red Cross for a candidate aged forty-four, with one year's training from 1921-22, followed by seven years' experience. The matter was referred back to the German Red Cross, the League considering that the candidate's training was below that of the general standard in Germany.

c) An application was received from the Hungarian Red Cross for a candidate aged forty who began her training in October 1928 and was to take her second year examination in June 1930. This has been referred back to the Hungarian Red Cross, the League considering that her training and experience are too short for her to benefit by the Course. It has been suggested that she complete her three years' training in Hungary and postpone taking the International Course until next year.

PUBLIC HEALTH COURSE

This candidate is a trained 'Fürsorgerin' (H.V.) and is highly recommended by Miss Danko, the Superintendent of Child Welfare work in Austria.

(11) Miss Eliamma Thomas.....India

(L.O.R.C.S. Half-scholarship

Indian Red Cross Half-scholarship)

This candidate is a trained Health Visitor and Midwife and is highly recommended.

In addition to the above applications one has been received from the Icelandic Red Cross, but application form has not yet been received.
