Report of Practical Work - Public Health Students,

August & September 1934

We have ten Public Health Students this year, six of whom are English speaking, and only three of whom have had no previous experience in Public Health Work.

The two English students are taking the Health Visitors Course and have had eight weeks C.O.S. work. I have excellent reports from the C.O.S. of both of them.

I attach a detailed programme of the work of the students during the last six weeks. I divided the time into two periods a 4 week period at first, and then a 2 week. For the 4 week period I try to choose the type of work which is familiar to the student in her own country, whether it is M. & C.W. or District Nursing, or work in a P.H. Department. During that time she usually has an opportunity of seeing other branches of work, and gets some idea of general social and housing conditions over here.

I have met the students regularly each week and discussed the work with them, advised a certain amount of relevant reading.

I am very grateful to St. Thomas's Hospital and Guy's Hospital Mothercraft Department, to the Queen's Institute of District Nursing and to the Westminster and Poplar Borough Councils for help they have given.

Two students, Miss Veilands and Miss Balabanova both wished to take the Social Work Course. By the programme we planned at this Committee I should have given them six full weeks I.C.A.A. work before term started. I was not, however, able to do this as the I.C.A.A. could not take them until September. They both, therefore, had two weeks with the District nurses, it helped them with their English and to see the home conditions, and I do not think it was wasted time.

Mrs. Reid has reported to you the result of this experience with the I.C.A.A.

I am planning for most of the students to spend one day a week for six weeks with the school nurses during this term.
