The business before the special meeting was to consider and to send forward to the Council of Bedford College the Committee's observations on the Report of a Study of the Facilities for Advanced Nursing Education in London both Professional and Academic, and of the Future Educational Policy of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation.

A copy of the Report of the Study Committee had been circulated to the Organisation Committee. There was also before the Committee a letter from the President of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation asking the Organisation Committee to consider in particular certain sections of the Report, which could not be carried through without the cooperation of Bedford College for Women. The particular sections referred to were Nos. 11, 12, 14, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34 and 36. The letter further asked that these recommendations should be submitted to the Council of Bedford College for their comments. The business therefore of the meeting was to advise the Council on the particular sections mentioned above.

The Committee proceeded to discuss the matter in considerable detail and asked that a report be drawn up on the lines of the decisions arrived at in the course of their discussion, and circulated to the Organisation Committee before being sent forward to the Council.
