Public Health Section Scholarships and Bursaries

The Section is offering bursaries (see cover ii) to enable College members to take the industrial nurses' courses arranged by the College in conjunction with Bedford College. The two courses, which will start early in October, are as follows:—(1) Course A, extending over an academic year and covering a period of not less than nine months. Certain courses of lectures together with tutorial work in classes will be arranged at Bedford College, and those of a more technical nature at the College. A certificate will be awarded on the results of an examination together with reports on the practical work. Fees: members, 30 guineas; nonmembers, 45 guineas. (2) Course B, a part time course, the lectures being arranged over a period of six months on one or two evenings a week. A statement as to satisfactory attendance will be given on completion. Fees: members, 6 guineas; non-members, 9 guineas. Scholarship examinations will be on September 5; entrance fee, 5s. Applications for entrance form for this examination to be made and returned complete before August 25, and application for bursaries before September 8, to Miss Wall, Secretary to the Public Health Section, College of Nursing.
