2. Programme for the 3 week Summer School.

A tentative programme for the 3 weeks Summer School was before the Committee who worked through the suggestions for each week. The following changes in the proposed programme were made:-

1st week.

- a. That Miss Hodgman's first lecture should be on Saturday, 21st July at 9 a.m. instead of on Thursday, 19th July, with consequent change in time of lectures by Miss Melhuish and Professor Edgell to 10 and 11 o'clock respectively.
- b. A note to be added to the effect that Discussion circles will be arranged if desired from 2 - 3.30 p.m. on Thursday and Friday. July 19th and 20th.

2nd week.

- a. To change "excursion" in each case to "Visit of Observation or Demonstration arranged by the College of Nursing."

3rd week,

- a. "Discussion" at 2.30 on Monday and Tuesday and "Excursion" on Thursday to read "Discussion or Visit of Observation or Demonstration for Hospital Group."
