Madam,

I am directed to state that the Board have decided that payments of grant to the Authorities of Institutions recognised under the Board's Regulations for the training of Health Visitors shall be made terminally under Article 12 of these Regulations and will be based on the number of students in attendance at the beginning of the academic year. I am accordingly to enclose two copies of Form 1060 M. in order that the necessary return may be submitted to the Board showing the number of recognised students on whose account instalment of grant is claimed under the Regulations referred to above for the session commencing *1<sup>st</sup> January, 1920.* One copy should accordingly be completed and returned to this Office at an early date.

In this connection I am to point out that the instalments will be instalments of the whole grant eventually payable, and the payments must not be regarded as committing the Board to paying grant on account of any particular student. It is accordingly unnecessary for the return to be delayed until the admission of each student has been finally settled.

I am also to request that a list may be forwarded together with a completed Form 1060 M showing the number of students who commenced the One Year Course at the beginning of the period in question and the grounds of their admission.
