
Dear Miss Monkhouse,

The Fifth Ordinary General Meeting of the Grand Council will be held on September 11th, 12th and 13th, 1946, in London. The present Committee of Management which was appointed by the Grand Council in 1939 will retire from office and a new Committee of Management will be appointed by the Grand Council for a period of two years from 1946 to 1948.

Under the present Constitution the Committee of Management includes a representative of the Educational Bodies co-operating in this scheme, and Bedford College is represented on the Committee of Management at the present time by Miss Jebb, M.A. Would you kindly let me know before July 11th, if Bedford College wish to re-nominate Miss Jebb for the period 1946 - 1948. This is necessary in order that re-appointments on the Committee of Management by be confirmed by the Grand Council in September.

May I take this opportunity of saying how greatly we appreciate the time and help which Miss Jebb has so generously given to the Foundation during the past years.
