Dear Mr. Bicknell,

I am sorry to have delayed so long before answering your letter of the 31st March, but I was waiting until we had come to a satisfactory agreement with the College of Nursing. I am now glad to be able to tell you that the College of Nursing is willing to co-operate with Bedford College on the lines proposed in Scheme 1 on the understanding that it is at liberty to withdraw from the agreement in two years from October 1927. My Council are prepared to agree to this proviso.

I note that the League is willing to sanction a subsidy for the salary of the nurse appointed by the College of Nursing in connection with the course. Doubtless we shall hear further particulars about this matter later.
