I have to thank you for the Report of the Committee appointed to consider the one year's course for qualified nurses for the Royal Sanitary Institute Diploma, and the Bedford College Public Health Workers' Certificate, which you have kindly sent for the observation of the Council of the College of Nursing.

The Report has been considered, and received general approval, but it is noted that it is not stated in what way the College of Nursing will co-operate with Bedford College in this course.

With reference to the proposed regulations, my Committee submits for the consideration of your Board, whether under regulation 4, the College of Nursing should not be associated with the certificate which will be awarded to successful candidates.
