Dear Dame Alicia,

In reply to your letter of November 16th I write to say that Bedford College are prepared to agree, with one small exception, to the payment of fees on the lines proposed in your letter referred to above, namely:-

- (a) International Students fees to be paid in two equal instalments in November and February of each year.
- (b) Payments in respect of Tutorship salary and superannuation contributions for Miss Baggallay to be paid in three equal instalments at the end of the months of November, March and June.

The end of July for the third instalment, as suggested in your letter, would be very inconvenient for the College as all final salary payments for the session are made by the College in June. It is greatly hoped that the Florence Nightingale International Foundation will be able to see their way to making this last payment in June and not July.
