That the preparatory work for the Certificate of the Sanitary Institute (at present the only recognised certificate under this Act) is included in the Bedford College Course, & forms in fact only a small portion of the instruction given. That this Examination is now actually taken by Bed. Coll. Students solely with a view to qualifying under this Act, while the Certificate ^{awarded} given by the College itself includes not only these requirements, but a much wider scientific & other ^{qualifications}.
