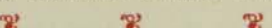

THE FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION

THE NATIONAL FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE COMMITTEE OF GREAT BRITAIN, which is promoting this Ball, is a unit in a great international movement, to raise a permanent and living Memorial to Florence Nightingale, which will carry on and extend her beneficent work.



The Memorial is to be in London, with headquarters at "Florence Nightingale International House," 15, Manchester Square, and will take the form of a post-graduate nursing education for a selected group of fully trained nurses drawn from those who stand in the forefront of their profession of all countries.



These courses of study are established at Bedford College (University of London), and since their inception 259 students from 43 countries have completed their training in England and returned to fill positions of great professional responsibility.



National Committees to collect funds have been formed in upwards of 20 countries, under the joint initiative of the National Red Cross Societies and National Nursing Organisations to collect for their funds.
