Dear Miss Monkhouse,

As soon as we hear from you we will send out the invitations and let you know the replies immediately we receive them.

I wonder if you would be so kind as to let me know if Bedford College has received the grant yet on behalf of Miss Hamblin, who took the Ministry of Health Visitors' examination last year? As we have already advanced this


