Dear Chairman,

I enclose a copy of a letter from the President of the Florence Nightingale International Foundation from which you will see that the Council of Bedford College is asked to reconstitute what is now known as the Committee for the Organisation of Courses for International Students so that it may include representatives of the Foundation. I think it important that this Committee, which must meet early in October, should be reconstituted at once. Will you give the Secretary authority to ask the special bodies concerned (the College of Nursing and the Florence Nightingale International Foundation) to nominate their representatives on the understanding that such nominations are confirmed by the Council at their first meeting in the autumn term? The constitution of the Committee, following the old lines

would be as follows:

The Principal (Chairman)

Full time Teachers at Bedford College concerned
in the course.

Part-time Tutors on the practical side.

3 representatives of the College of Nursing.

2 representatives of the Florence Nightingale
International Foundation (replacing 2 represen-
tatives of the League of Red Cross Societies).
