Public Health Students - October 1935 to January 1936.

It is not usual for the students to have any work during the Christmas Vacation as they are expected to have a holiday.

It was necessary, however, to arrange for Miss Flambert to work, because she would not otherwise get enough practical ex-perience before July to be signed up for the Health Visitors' examination. She has therefore been in the Public Health Department of St. Marylebone since Christmas and will continue there for one day a week all this term.

The other students went to Birmingham for five days and were there shown the Maternity and Child Welfare and School Nursing work. They had a very excellent programme arranged for them by the Public Health Department and also visited the Bournville Factory and Village.

Miss Abelgas has particularly asked for school nursing work. She will be able to see the London work during this term, but this is not very satisfactory, except on the Clinical side, and I expect to arrange something for her in a suburban town later.

Three of the students have asked to have some observation abroad during the Easter vacation. I think I could arrange a useful and instructive tour for them in France, Yugoslavia and Hungary if the Committee approved.

They will have had 9 weeks observation work in this country by the end of this term.
