

Minutes of a meeting of the Sub-Committee of the Organisation Committee set up to consider the proposed new appointment of Tutor in Practical Work for the International Students.

The Sub-Committee of the Organisation Committee met on Monday, 31st January 1938, to draw up draft conditions of appointment for the proposed new appointment of Tutor in Practical Work for the International Students. They agreed on the conditions of appointment for recommendation to the Councils of Bedford College and of the College of Nursing.

The Committee proceeded to consider the name which is to be put before the Councils of both Colleges in connection with the appointment. The name considered was Miss Daisy Bridges. The Committee were reminded that Miss Bridges had been an International Student at Bedford College for the year 1936-37 and at the close of her course she had been given a Certificate with distinction in the whole course. The Committee were further informed that the Rockefeller Foundation had awarded Miss Bridges a travelling scholarship which she is at present using in Canada. No other name was put forward.

Recommended that Miss Daisy Bridges be appointed Tutor to the International Students on the terms recommended in the draft conditions of appointment.
