Dear Madam,

I very greatly regret that the prolongation of the diplomatic conference of Geneva in which I participated, made it impossible for me to respond to your very kind suggestion that I should be present at the informal meeting of the Committee appointed by Bedford College for the organization of courses for International Students on July 11th. Mr. de Gielgud, no doubt, communicated to you the regrets both of the Vice-President of the League, Colonel Draudt, and of myself for the unfortunate circumstances which prevented us attending the meeting personally.

I wish to take this occasion to express once again the very sincere appreciation of the League of Red Cross Societies for the invaluable assistance which Bedford College for Women has given to the League during the past six years in the development of these International Courses. What was undertaken as an experiment in international education has, I think, more than demonstrated the necessity and value of these Courses. The success which has attended our efforts was due almost entirely to the appreciative interest and support on the part of Bedford College.
