In the absence of Mr. Kittredge I beg to acknowledge, with many thanks, receipt of your letter of July 6th, inviting him to attend the informal meeting of the Committee for the organization of courses for International Students on Monday, July 11th, at 11.15 a.m.

It would have given Mr. Kittredge much satisfaction to attend this meeting, but he has unfortunately just been obliged to notify us by telegram that the International Relief Conference which he is attending in Geneva, is unexpectedly prolonged and that he will consequently be unable to keep his engagements in London at the beginning of next week. He has asked me to go to London in his place, and if your Committee will accept this substitution, I shall be much honoured to be allowed to attend the meeting on Monday morning.
