Dear Miss Monkhouse,

Very many thanks for your letter of February 5th with reference to Colonel Parkinson's interview with Sir Austen Chamberlain.

We sent a copy of your letter to Sir Arthur Stanley and asked him to approach Sir Austen Chamberlain and also the American Ambassador. We will let you know later if he has any success and will then send you a copy of the draft programme for your approval.

I have just received your letter of February 6th. I expect to be in London early in March but am not yet sure of the date. As soon as it is settled I will let you know, when another meeting of your Committee could be called.

If the Provisional Committee were to agree to the Course in Social Studies and we had even only one or two students, it would be a beginning. I am writing to a few of the countries to find out what prospect there would be of having students for such a course and how such an idea would be received. I shall probably have answers to my letters before March and will then be able to let you know what prospects there are for the Session 1934/35. As soon as the date for my next visit to London is fixed I will let you know.
