Dear Mrs. Carter,

I enclose a copy of a letter from the College of Nursing.

You will see that they only wish to bind themselves for two years from October 1927. I have little doubt that the Council of Bedford College will be prepared to accept this shorter period, but the matter will have to go before them at their next meeting on May 19th. In the mean time I should be glad to know whether you yourself approve of the two year agreement plan, and whether you think it will be acceptable to your Paris Committee.

May I point out that the new Committee will not hold Office until the beginning of next session, that is from September 1927, and consequently all admissions for next session will be carried through as hitherto by the present Joint Advisory Committee.
