Report of Public Health Students.

May 1932

The Students spent three weeks during the Easter Vacation in observation work outside London.

They were allotted variously to the Counties of East Sussex, Gloucestershire, Kent and Surrey, where their programmes were planned by the County Medical Officers and the County Superintendents of Nurses.

They visited with the district nurses who were doing nursing and health visiting work, and they also had opportunities of studying the organisation and supervision of the nurses' work.

Miss Nobes, one of the Old International Students, took Miss Picova for a week's observation with her. Miss Jacob had an interesting week with a travelling Health Exhibit organised by the Central Council for Maternity & Child Welfare.

I think the Students benefit by this experience in the country where conditions are perhaps more similar to their own than they are in London. I have good reports of their interest and understanding.
