Dear Director Marion Ferguson,

Thank you very much indeed for both of your letters and the material on nursing education. There is a nation wide discussion going on here about what should be more rational, a four year program or a five year one. Because of my personal involvement in that procedure I did not answer you at once. Waiting for final settlements I intended to pass to you more precise information on our Polish nursing studies and what has been adopted from your program. I will report anything of interest to you in the future.

Meanwhile I took advantage of large portions of your elaborate to the London University Senate about social principles in nurse training. I just brought them to the public speaking on the opening ceremony of nurse graduation. They all were deeply impressed by the finest arguments of yours. I will still more talk on that issue to our senate.

In the past I tried often to gain funds to cover your trip to Poland. Foreign currency can be granted to foreigners only on governemental order. I will look for personal connections being in Warsaw in September. There is no other socialistic way possible to realize your visit to Wrocław. You will hear from me on that as soon as an opportunity will arise.
