Dear Mrs. Reid,

Yesterday I sent off the letter to the Commonwealth Fund and I enclose a copy of the final draft. I consulted the Principal and Professor Edgell, hence the reason for a few alterations from your original suggestions.

With regard to the syllabus, I think you will agree that this is not yet in a form suitable for printing and forwarding to America so I am enclosing a copy with the request that you will let me know how you would like it altered before sending to the Commonwealth Fund. There is no detail about the courses in Psychiatry and I presume they will want to know more exactly what is intended.

I arranged with the Principal that the heading should be somewhat as follows:- "Curriculum for a year's course for Qualified Nurses arranged by a joint committee of Bedford College for Women and the College of Nursing." Do you approve?

I am so sorry to trouble you about this in the vacation but Professor Edgell is very desirous that Dr. Barry Smith should receive the syllabus as soon as possible.

I am sending a letter to Miss Rundle informing her that Bedford College is making an appeal to the Commonwealth Fund.
