Dear Miss Monkhouse,

Very many thanks for your letter of June 13th enclosing a copy of the minutes of the last meeting.

We are quite in agreement with the form of words in which it is proposed to recognize the co-operation of the School of Hygiens and Tropical Medicine and a slip, as suggested, has been added to the remaining copies of the curriculum and we have also put a notice in the League's Bulletin.

We will have three new applications to bring before the Committee for admission, besides the two which were referred from the last meeting. The applications from Yugoslavia and Australia have not yet arrived so that the admission of the candidates from these countries will probably have to be postponed until October.

The total number of students will be seventeen unless somebody falls out at the last moment.

I expect to be in London late on Monday night so that if there is anything you want to talk over with me before the meeting I will be glad to come a little earlier. I will bring over with me copies of the memorandum for the members of the Committee.
